## Goal: Increase Positive Social Connections

### IMPACT

1. 100% of youth reported feeling accepted by their Breakaway peers
2. 100% of youth reported having established a positive connection with program mentors

## Goal: Improve Academic Success

### IMPACT

- The vast majority of time youth accomplished their daily homework goals:
3. 92% of the time among middle school youth
  4. 87% of the time among high school youth

## Goal: Increase Higher Education Opportunities

### IMPACT

5. 92% of active Breakaway seniors have pursued post-high school education
6. To date, Breakaway has awarded \$3,500 in college scholarship funds

## Breakaway by the Numbers

2013-2014 program year to date

7. Youth served to date: 183  
High school, 76; Middle school, 107  
80% male; 20% female

8. Average daily attendance  
GOAL: 18/DAY  
High school site: 18.5/day  
Middle school site: 17/day

9. Frequency of attendance  
GOAL: 65% ACTIVE RATE  
80% active middle school youth  
68% active high school youth

10. Staffed Positions  
2 Lead Teachers; 7 paid tutors; 1 volunteer tutor; 5 paid coaches
